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Center for Developmentally Disabled completes \$1 million capital campaign

For immediate release – Center for Developmentally Disabled in Kansas City, MO has raised \$1 million to complete its capital campaign. A celebration is planned for 4:30 – 7:30 PM, November 1, 2018 at the CDD offices located at 9150 E. 41st Terrace (across from the Royal and Chiefs Stadium Complexes). The reception for supporters and friends will include an Art Exhibit featuring artists from within the organization who receive services.

Honorary Chairpersons, Congressman Emanuel and Mrs. Dianne Cleaver, kicked off the campaign in August of 2017 for the purpose of creating an Enrichment Center for persons with developmental disabilities and to address one-time repairs and upgrades to CDD’s new program and administrative building. .

“CDD completed a rigorous strategic planning process to create a clear path forward on building our Enrichment Center where we will offer services to individuals with developmental disabilities. The success of our Capital Campaign has made our mission-- *to support persons with disabilities in achieving their fullest potential--* possible.
